



The medium climbs up to Mulholland and takes that east to Cahuenga. The short climbs only up to Hollywood Blvd and takes that east to Cahuenga. The two routes are the same after that as they ride through Griffith Park, Elysian Park, past the restored Victorian houses on Carroll St and on to Chinatown for a break. That left only Russ and me to do the entire route. We stopped for the usual group shot up on Carroll Street, but it was a far cry from a few years ago when we had 10 to 15 riders in the group

Patches of the Week: These are a few of the Christmas Ride patches given to me by **Laverne Boethling:**




